#### A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Metro Tasmania Act 1997* for the purposes of prohibiting Metro Tasmania from charging a fare for public transport services

Be it enacted by Her Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows

### **PART 1 – PRELIMINARY**

#### 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Metro Tasmania (Free Public Transport) Amendment Act 2023*.

### 2. Commencement

This Act commences on the first anniversary of the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

# 3. Principal Act

In this Part, the *Metro Tasmania Act 1997\** is referred to as the Principal Act.

### 4. Section 19D inserted

After section 19C of the Principal Act, the following section is inserted in Part 4:

# 19D. Company may not charge fares

The company may not charge a fee to passengers for passenger transport services.

# 5. Section 22 Repealed

Section 22 of the Principal Act is repealed.
