Lily Blundstone – Conviction

Given that Ms Blundstone was working at the time, towing a trailer with defective brakes provided by her employer, working 18 hours straight with only a 14-minute break and being paid in cash, and was not covered by workers compensation, what action is the government taking against Ben Yole Racing, her employer, who put Miss Blundstone in this position?
