

## MONDAY, 4 JULY, 1864.

MINUTE No. 182.

THE Governor in Council grants a Pension at the rate of  $\pounds 17\ 15s.\ 9d.$  to John Russell, for loss of office as Constable at the Aborigines' Establishment at Oyster Cove: to be charged against the Land Fund.

## THURSDAY, 7 JULY, 1864.

MINUTE No. 186.

The Colonial Secretary lays on the Table the Papers (certified by the Auditor) relating to the Pension awarded to the late Lord Bishop of Tasmania, from which it appears that the correct amount, and that which has actually been paid to the Bishop, is £300 per annum, although it is stated in the Minute of 19th October, 1863, as £333 6s. 8d.; and submits that the Clerk be authorised to alter the amount expressed in that Minute accordingly.

The Governor in Council directs that the correction be made by a reference to the present Minute. (*Vide* Minute, No. 186, 7 July, 1864.)
