### PETITION

# FROM LICENSED VICTUALLERS.—REDUCTION OF LICENCE FEE.

Presented by Mr. Dunn, and ordered by the House to be printed, 28 October, 1857.



To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the House of Assembly of Tasmania, in Parliament assembled.

The humble Petition of the undersigned Licensed Victuallers of the City of Hobart Town, in Tasmania.

#### **RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:**

THAT your Petitioners are Licensed Victuallers carrying on business in Hobart Town.

That your Petitioners have had their attention directed to a Bill now before your Honourable House, intituled "A Bill to regulate the Sale of Fermented and Spirituous Liquors."

That your Petitioners find by the said Bill that the sum of Fifty Pounds is the Fee to be imposed for a Public-house Licence for the year One thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight.

That your Petitioners humbly beg leave to state, that for a length of time considerable depression has prevailed in the state of things in this City, which has been severely felt and is now experienced by your Petitioners in their lawful calling.

That your Petitioners would further state, with all humility, that the sum of Fifty Pounds per annum for a Public-house Licence appears to your Petitioners enormous, and a grievous infliction upon them in the present condition of the Colony.

That your Petitioners humbly submit to your Honourable House that, as an important section of the trading interests of this City, they ought not to be called upon to contribute to the Public Revenue in a greater ratio than the Licensed Victuallers of the adjacent Colonies are subject to; in proof of which your Petitioners need only point to the fact that in Victoria the Publican's Licence is fixed at the sum of Twenty-five Pounds a year, being a reduction of Seventy-five per cent. upon the former Licence Fee of that Colony.

That, at a period in this Colony when the business of your Petitioners was infinitely more brisk and profitable, the Annual Licence Fee was only Twenty-five Pounds.

Your Petitioners, therefore, most humbly pray that your Honourable House will be pleased to take the premises into its earnest consideration; and further to grant the respectful and reasonable request of your Petitioners by reducing the Fee for a Publichouse Licence, for the year now next ensuing, from the heavy sum of Fifty Pounds to the sum of Twenty-five Pounds, as was the case in the more flourishing condition of this Colony.

And your Petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray, &c.
