ANNUAL REPORT for 1873.

I HAVE the honor to lay before the Government the Annual Report for the year ending 31st December, 1873.

The number of admissions during the year was in excess (by 102) of the former year, and the mortality was less.

The fees received from paying patients was upwards of £100 more than in the preceding year.

There was no change in the economy of the Hospital during the past year which calls for notice.

REPORT of the Surgeon Superintendent.

DURING the past year there were admitted into Hospital 983 Patients, of whom 678 were males and 305 females.

There were remaining under treatment at the commencement of the year 66 ; so that the total number treated during the year ending 31st December, 1873, was 1049. Of these 890 were discharged, 94 died, and 65 remain under treatment.

Nine persons died on the day of admission, 7 on the day after, 8 on the second day, 3 on the third, 3 on the fourth, 4 on the fifth, and 4 on the sixth day.

Of the Patients admitted 134 were self-supporting, 19 were either wholly or in part chargeable to Imperial Funds, and 896 were Colonial Paupers.

The number of Out-Patients treated during the year was 4998, the number of prescriptions was 8983.
