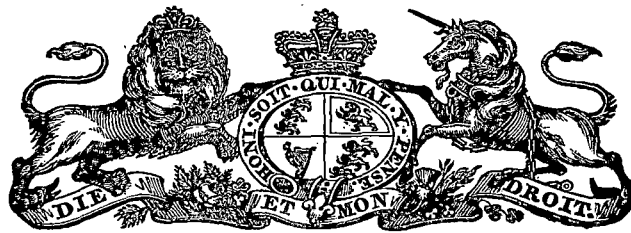

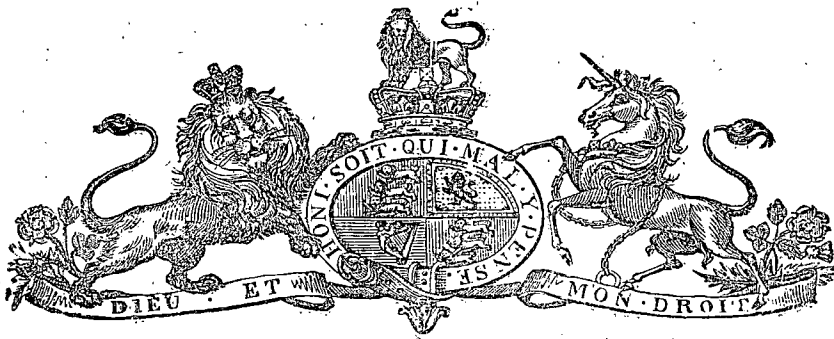

I HAVE the honor to request that you will be good enough to inform me what Districts remain to be visited and valued by you, and when you think it probable that the work in connexion with the valuation of all the Districts in the Colony will be completed.

SIR,

WE have the honor to acknowledge your letter of the 17th instant, and in reply thereto to inform you that the only Districts which remain to be visited and valued are as follows; viz.—A portion of Hobart, the whole of Kingborough, Franklin, George Town, and Selby.

We find some difficulty in estimating the time within which the work remaining to be done in visiting these Districts, valuing the properties therein, and preparing new Valuation Rolls of them, will be completed.

The present is the worst season of the year for such work, and the roads in the different Districts will be in a worse condition than at any time of the year.

Taking into consideration these difficulties, and presuming that the weather will not be more than usually unfavorable, we expect to complete the valuation of all the Districts of the Colony by the end of January next (1877).
