

## THE PUBLIC DEBTS SINKING FUND:

REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE, 1883.

Laid upon the Table by the Treasurer, September 4, 1883, and ordered by the House to be printed.

Sir,

WE have the honor to report to you, for the information of Parliament, our proceedings since the 1st July, 1882, on which date we made our first Report in accordance with the provisions of "The Public Debts Sinking Fund Act, 1881," Section 6.

During the year ending the 30th June last we held several meetings, and invested moneys at our disposal in the purchase of Government Debentures, bearing interest at the rate of Four per cent. per annum.

The capital now invested amounts to the sum of £71,100, bearing interest at the rate of Four per cent. per annum, and yielding a yearly income of £2844.

We append a statement showing the years during which the Debentures held by us will be paid off by the Treasury.

The Debenture Bonds have been examined by the Colonial Auditor and found correct.

Copies of the Abstract of Receipts and Expenditure and Investment Account are submitted with this Report for the information of Parliament, having been examined by the Colonial Auditor and passed.
