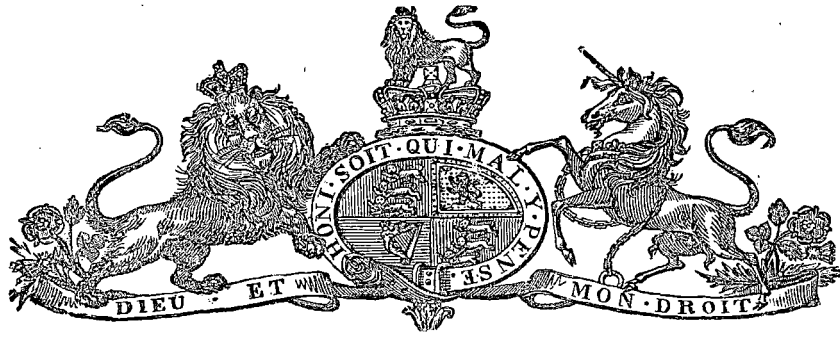

THE SELECT COMMITTEE appointed on the 25th of July last to revise the **STANDING ORDERS** of the Council have agreed to the following **PROGRESS REPORT**.

THE Committee has had before it Rules adapted from those of the House of Commons by the Clerk, and also suggested Amendments by a Member of the Council; but the Committee is of opinion that no change should be made in the Rules during the present Session; but that the Committee should be re-appointed in the next Session.
