CLAUSE NOTES

BIOSECURITY (CONSEQUENTIAL AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS) BILL 2020

Clause I Short title

The Biosecurity (Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Act 2020.

Clause 2 Commencement

The Act will commence on receiving Royal Assent. Certain parts of the Act will only commence when specified provisions of the *Biosecurity Act* 2019 commence.

Clause 3 Interpretation

Defines certain terms used in the Act.

Clause 4 Savings and transitional regulations

Enables the making of regulations of a savings or transitional nature to facilitate the transition from the old legislation to the new framework under the *Biosecurity Act 2019*.

Clause 5 Consequential amendments – Biosecurity Act 2019

Updates legislative references in the legislation specified in Schedule 1.

Clause 6 Consequential amendments – Animal Brands and Movement Act 1984

Updates legislative references in the legislation specified in Schedule 2.

Clause 7 Consequential amendments – Animal Farming (Registration) Act 1994

Updates legislative references in the legislation specified in Schedule 3.

Clause 8 Consequential amendments – Animal Health Act 1995

Updates legislative references in the legislation specified in Schedule 4.

Clause 9 Consequential amendments – Weed Management Act 1999

Updates legislative references in the legislation specified in Schedule 5.

Clause 10 Effect of certain consequential amendments

Clarifies that any regulations amended by this Act may be further amended by subsequent regulations.

Clause II Administrative arrangements

Makes the Minister for Primary Industries and Water the responsible Minister for administration of the Act, subject to any subsequent Administrative Arrangements Order.

<u>Schedule I</u> Consequential amendments – Biosecurity Act 2019

Specifies consequential amendments to the *Inland Fisheries Act 1995*; and a series of regulations made under the *Primary Produce Safety Act 2011*.

Schedule 2 Consequential amendments – Animal Brands and Movement Act 1984

Specifies consequential amendments to the Approvals (Deadlines) Act 1993.

Schedule 3 Consequential amendments – Animal Farming (Registration) Act 1994

Specifies consequential amendments to the Nature Conservation Act 2002.

Schedule 4 Consequential amendments – Animal Health Act 1995

Specifies consequential amendments to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act 1995; Animal Brands and Movement Act 1984; Animal Farming (Registration) Act 1994; Animal Welfare Act 1993; Approvals (Deadlines) Act 1993; Criminal Code 1924; Firearms Act 1996; Nature Conservation Act 2002; and Vermin Control Act 2000.

<u>Schedule 5</u> Consequential amendments – Weed Management Act 2002

Specifies consequential amendments to the Boundary Fences Act 1908; Rail Infrastructure Act 2007; and Roads and Jetties Act 1935.
