

CLAUSE NOTES

Sentencing Amendment (Drug Treatment Orders) Bill 2016

- Clause 1: Short title of the Act.
- Clause 2: The Act commences on the day it receives Royal Assent.
- Clause 3: Principal Act is the *Sentencing Act 1997*.
- Clause 4: Inserts a definition of drug treatment order as having the same meaning as under section 27B of the Principal Act.
- Clause 5: Repeals section 27Y to remove the expiration provision applying to Part 3A of the Principal Act.
- Clause 6: Inserts section 104A to provide that any action, decision, direction, requirement, order, warrant, sentence made after 30 June 2014 under Part 3A is not to be taken as invalid or contravene the Principal Act or any other Act.
- Clause 7: Provides that this Act is repealed a year after it commences.
