- **Inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's process into the feasibility planning for a new sporting and event stadium in Hobart**

The Parliamentary Standing Committee of Public Accounts has held four days of public hearings in Hobart and Launceston and will have additional hearings in June 2023. The Committee has resolved to hear from the Premier and AFL Tasmania, noting that Mr Gill McLachlan (CEO, AFL) despite being invited has not attended a public hearing to provide evidence.

On Friday, 5 May 2023, the Committee received a response from Minister Barnett around the questions and request for information taken on notice on 24 March 2023: these are being considered by the Committee.
