### THIRD PROGRESS REPORT.

THE Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to present the following Third Progress Report:—

#### DEVONPORT MUNICIPALITY.

Your Committee has taken into consideration the application of the Municipality of Devonport for a further loan of £20,000 for additional water-supply; and now recommends the same to the favourable consideration of Your Honourable House, with provision for a 1 per cent. per annum sinking fund.

#### FINGAL MUNICIPALITY.

Your Committee then proceeded to consider the application of the Fingal Municipality for a further loan of £1600 for additional water-supply; and it was resolved to recommend the same to the favourable consideration of Your Honourable House, with provision for a 2 per cent. per annum sinking fund.
