Earlier this year, Women Speak Tasmania posted on their Facebook page that representatives from their organisation met with the Attorney-General, Guy Barnett, about Tasmania's Birth, Deaths and Marriages Registration Regulations 2019. The meeting was very productive and Mr Barnett expressed considerable interest in the impressive body of evidence put forward and committed to looking further into the issues raised.

The law reform in 2019 has been overwhelmingly positive and has done no harm to anybody outside the transgender and gender diverse community. Will the Attorney-General rule out repealing those 2019 reforms and give Tasmanians a clear commitment that they will not be at risk under his leadership of that portfolio?
