On Tuesday, 23 September 2025 the Legislative Council agreed to the re-establishment of two Government Administration Sessional Committees in the following terms —

1. SESSIONAL COMMITTEE A ON GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION

1.1 The Sessional Committee A on Government Administration is re-established.

1.2 The Committee consists of not less than 5 members.

1.3 The functions of the Committee are to inquire into and report on any matter relating to —

- (b) The administration, processes, practices and conduct of any department, agency, Government Business Enterprise, State-owned Company, or other entity for which the following Ministers are responsible —

 - III. Minister for Health, Mental Health and Wellbeing
 - IV. Minister for Ageing
 - V. Minister for Aboriginal Affairs
 - VI. Minister for Energy and Renewables
 - VII. Minister for Parks
 - VIII. Minister for Sport
 - IX. Minister for Environment
 - X. Minister for Innovation, Science and Digital Economy
 - XI. Minister for Community and Multicultural Affairs
 - XII. Minister for Arts and Heritage
 - XIII. Minister for Infrastructure and Transport
 - XIV. Minister for Local Government
 - XV. Minister for Housing and Planning
- (c) The administration, processes, practices and conduct of any other entity including those entities in which local government has an interest.

2. SESSIONAL COMMITTEE B ON GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION

2.1 The Sessional Committee B on Government Administration is re-established.

 - VI. Minister for Business, Industry and Resources
 - VII. Minister for Skills and Jobs
 - VIII. Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Management
 - IX. Minister for Tourism, Hospitality and Events
 - X. Minister for Racing
 - XI. Minister for Women and the Prevention of Family Violence
 - XII. Minister for Education
 - XIII. Minister for Children and Youth
 - XIV. Minister for Disability Services
 - XV. Minister for Primary Industries and Water
 - XVI. Minister for Veterans' Affairs
