      - X. Minister for Innovation, Science and Digital Economy
      - XI. Minister for Community and Multicultural Affairs
      - XII. Minister for Arts and Heritage
      - XIII. Minister for Infrastructure and Transport
      - XIV. Minister for Local Government
      - XV. Minister for Housing and Planning
    - (c) The administration, processes, practices and conduct of any other entity including those entities in which local government has an interest.

## 2. SESSIONAL COMMITTEE B ON GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION

    - XI. Minister for Women and the Prevention of Family Violence

    - XV. Minister for Primary Industries and Water
    - XVI. Minister for Veterans' Affairs
