



REPORT FOR 1884-5.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



ANNUAL REPORT of the Tasmanian Council of Education for the Year 1884-85.

To His Excellency Sir George Cumine Strahan, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies.

#### MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY.

1. In conformity with the provisions of "The Tasmanian Council of Education and 22 Vict. No. 1, learning Act." we have the honor to submit this our Twenty-fifth Report of the Section 30. Scholarship Act," we have the honor to submit this our Twenty-fifth Report of the proceedings of the Council from 1st May, 1884, to 30th April, 1885.

2. The Right Rev. the Bishop of Tasmania was elected President for the year President. ending 30th June, 1885.

3. The Annual Examination of Candidates for the Council of Education Exhibitions Council of was held in the month of June, 1884. Twelve Candidates, all males, presented themselves for examination; and, on the recommendation of the Examiners, Exhibitions of Gazette the annual value of £20 each for four years were awarded to the under-mentioned Notice, 24 Candidates:—Charles Benson Barnett, High School; Thomas James Stubbs, Hutchins School; Frederick Henry Cox, Hutchins School; Oliver Lindley Adams, Church Grammar School, Launceston; Lyndhurst Falkiner Giblin, Hutchins School.

The Examiners, in closing their Report, observe:-

"The general result of the Examination compares very favourably with that of last year, and is probably the most satisfactory that has hitherto been attained.

We are again glad to observe that the four Senior Candidates are all Exhibitioners under the Board of Education."

4. The twenty-fifth examination for the Degree of Associate of Arts was held in Degree of December, 1884,—the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D., being Examiner in English, French, Associate of Latin, Greek, History, Geography, and Geology; H. C. Kingsmill, Esq., M.A., Notice, 13th Examiner in Pure Mathematics, Chemistry, and Natural Philosophy; the Rev. Thos. Jan., 1885. Kelsh, Examiner in Italian; Henry Hunter, Esq., Examiner in Drawing; and J. Summers, Esq., Examiner in Music. Seventeen Candidates under nineteen years of age presented themselves, and eleven succeeded in obtaining the Degree—five being placed in the First Class, two in the Second Class, and four in the Third Class.

One Candidate over nineteen years of age presented, but failed to secure the Degree. Walter Thomas Price, as Senior Associate of the year, received the Council's Gold Medal; he also gained the First Prize for English, Second Prize for Italian, and a Prize for Geology. Prizes were also awarded to the under-mentioned Associates who were placed in the First Class, as follows:—John Thomas Wilson, First Prizes for Latin, Greek, and Mathematics, Second Prize for French, and a Prize for Natural Philosophy; James Edward Miles Roche, Prize for Drawing; Beatrice Mary Hudspeth, Council's Silver Medal as Senior French Associate of the year, First Prizes for French, German, and Italian, Second Prize for English, and a Prize for French; and in the Second Class, Walter John Johnstone, Second Prize for Mathematics.

Tasmanian Scholarships, Gazette Notice, 13th Jan. 1885.

5. The Examination for Tasmanian Scholarships took place in December last, and was conducted by the Rev. J. E. Bromby, D.D., and H. C. Kingsmill, Esq., M.A., J. A. Jackson, Esq., B.A., taking the German. Six Candidates presented themselves; two—James Harcourt Smith, A.A., 1881, and Frederick Charles Hales, A.A., 1881—reached the standard prescribed by the Council. A Scholarship was awarded to each of them, and they have since proceeded to Great Britain to enter upon their University studies.

Two other Candidates—Ralph Stuart Stephenson, A.A., 1882, and Edward Arthur Lamprill, A.A., 1883—came within the limits of eligibility for a Scholarship.

Progress of Tasmanian Scholars.

6. With regard to the progress of Tasmanian Scholars in Great Britain, we learn that Mr. Rock, in the results of his last College examination, stood second on the list. He intends to present himself this month for the Mathematical Tripos. Mr. Waterhouse is at present attending lectures on Engineering under Professor Stewart. Mr. Tofft successfully passed his first professional examination in October last, but owing to illness since then his studies have been somewhat retarded. Mr. Allport is steadily working at Christ's College, Cambridge. Mr. Macnamara has begun his career successfully, having passed in three examinations in the School of Medicine at Edinburgh, obtaining a First Prize and a Silver Medal; he averaged in the three examinations 89 per cent., the second man averaging 78 per cent.

Mr. Dowdell is still prosecuting his studies at the University Hospital, London,

having passed in Anatomy and Physiology in the winter examination.

Minor Scholarships.

7. The two Minor Scholarships at the disposal of the Council for the year have been awarded to Walter Thomas Price and John Thomas Wilson, they having intimated their intention to study and compete for a Tasmanian Scholarship. These Scholarships are each of the value of £40 per annum, and are tenable for two years.

Dry Scholar-ship.

8. The Dry Scholarship was awarded to Walter Thomas Price, Senior Associate of the year, he having announced his intention of studying for the Tasmanian Scholarship Examination.

Local Examination for Matriculation University.

9. Since the publication of our last Report two examinations for Matriculation at the University of Melbourne have been held in Hobart under our supervision. At the Examination known as "end of February Term," which was held in June, 1884, three Candidates presented themselves; one of these, Alfred Ernest Johns, succeeded in passing both the Matriculation and Civil Service Examinations. For the October Term Examination, which was held in December, to which five, three male and two female Candidates, were admitted, Miss Grace A. Boyes and Miss Mary Roberts were the only two who succeeded in passing in sufficient subjects to matriculate.

Gilchrist Scholarship Examination.

10. The second examination for the Gilchrist Scholarship under the new conditionsi.e., annual examination open to any of the Australian Colonies—was held in January There were two Candidates, but we have not yet ascertained the result.

London University Matriculation Examination.

11. An examination for Matriculation at the London University was held under our supervision in June last. One Candidate presented himself, but he was not successful.

12. For some time past we have had under consideration the advantages to be Alteration in gained by altering the time for holding Tasmanian Scholarship Examinations from December to June in each year, thus enabling a Tasmanian Scholar to enter a British University in the October following. Accordingly in January last we sought and Scholarship obtained Your Excellency's approval to the following Regulations on the subject:

Scholarship and A. A. Degree.

amination for Tasmanian Degree.

- "1. That in the year 1886, and in each subsequent year, the examinations for the Tasmanian Scholarships and for the Degree of Associate of Arts be held on such days in the month of June as the Council may from time to time fix and determine.
- "2. That the 1st day of June in the year 1886, and in each subsequent year, be fixed and appointed as the day upon which the ages of Candidates for the Degree of Associate of Arts and for Tasmanian Scholarships be ascertained and computed in those years.
- "3. That each of the Scholarships to be awarded in the year 1886, and in each subsequent year, shall be tenable for the period of Four years commencing on the 1st day of October in the year in which the same is awarded.
- "4. The notice which by the 27th Section of "The Tasmanian Council of Education and Scholarship Act," (22 Vict. No. 21), is required to be given by Candidates for the Degree of Associate of Arts and Tasmanian Scholarships, shall be, in each case, at least one month next before the first day of June in the year in which such Candidate desires to present himself for examination.
- "5. All previous rules, regulations, and resolutions of the Council inconsistent with the practice hereby established are rescinded."
- 13. During the year we framed a Draft Bill for the establishment of a University in Proposed Tasmania, but, owing to various causes, legislation on the subject was postponed for the present.

14. We submit a Statement of the Disbursements of the Council between the 1st Financial January and the 31st December, 1884, the termination of the financial year, together with a Supplementary Statement of payments between the 1st January and the 30th April, 1885. The total expenditure under every head for the year 1884 is shown to have amounted to £2618 0s. 6d.

15. We append to our Report a Roll of the Tasmanian Scholars, a List of those Appendices Students who have obtained the Degree of Associate of Arts, and a List of those who A, B, and C. obtained Exhibitions offered by the Council.
