

REGULATION UNDER "THE GOLD FIELDS REGULATION ACT, 1870."

By virtue of "The Gold Fields Regulation Act, 1870," His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth make the following Regulation, to take effect on and from the 1st of October, 1880:—

Miners' Rights.—90. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Regulation No. 88, a Miner's Right shall be issued to any person applying for the same between the first day of October and the thirty-first day of December, both included, in any year upon payment of a fee of Two shillings and sixpence.
