



Very full details of the Roads, &c., down to the end of 1861, are furnished in the Parliamentary Paper, No. 158, 1861, to which I would beg to refer.

The distribution of the Costs of surveying the various lines of Road cannot be furnished from this Office.

The only line of Road abandoned is a portion of that from Tarleton to Sheffield, $vi\hat{a}$ Badger Gorge, in consequence of the probable great cost.

The clearing of other lines of Road have only been deferred to ascertain whether there would be any funds available after the Works at present in hand were completed.
