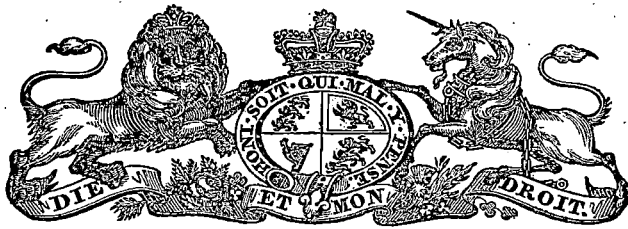

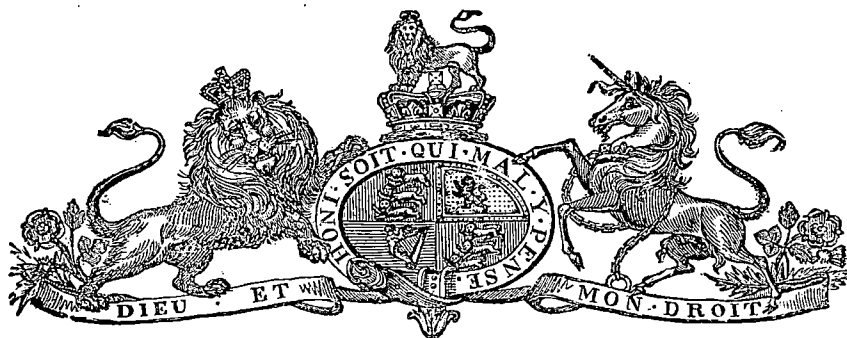

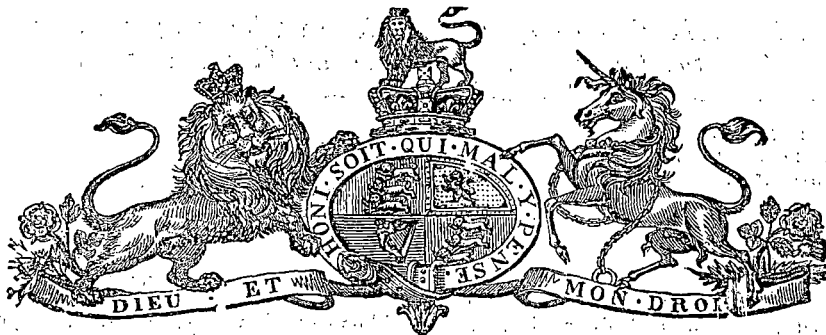

The Huon Track, 3rd July, 1868.

DEAR SIR,

I herewith beg to return you the Map of my District. I have looked over it very carefully and distinguished by different colours (as directed) the various classes of Crown Land, as truthfully as my knowledge of the several localities enabled me to do, and having been honoured with the charge of the District so long (upwards of 10 years), there are not many accessible parts of it but what I have been over at some time or other. You will find a rough schedule of quantities above.

That extensive block of Crown Land lying between the Huon and New Norfolk, chiefly in the Parishes of Throckmorton and Ranelagh, is from its intense density as yet comparatively unexplored, but judging from the description of timber (Silver Wattle), as seen in the distance, indicates a vast quantity of good land. It is a pity but that the cash advanced to cut tracks into the unknown parts were not spent in opening up this locality, instead of being lavished in the Sand Fly Basin, which is as well known as any lands possibly can be from the tracks formerly cut there by myself, and gone over by you subsequently.

The same rule applies to the land in the vicinity of Mounts "Victoria" and "Young."

SIR, I RETURN the plan of the District, on which, in accordance with your instructions, I have represented in colours the area of the Agricultural and Pastoral Crown Lands; also of that, the quality of which is unknown to me.

The Agricultural Land in this District seldom occurs in large blocks of uniform quality, but is almost always interspersed with stony rises of little value. The area coloured red must not, therefore, be considered as all fit for cultivation, but as representing land which is chiefly of an agricultural character,—and of which about one-half is saleable, and perhaps one-third fit for cultivation.

The Pastoral Land in Buckingham and Monmouth and in Cumberland (South of the Dee, about 90,000 acres) is principally of poor quality, and not capable of supporting more than one sheep to four or five acres, and unsuited for cattle. It is however “sound,”—that is, not subject to fluke. That north of the Dee (Cumberland and Lincoln) is good,—a large proportion being capable of supporting two sheep to three acres,—but unsuited for lambing, and as nearly all is subject to fluke, sheep cannot be pastured on it with profit. It is better adapted for breeding cattle, and considerable areas are occupied, for which no rent is paid.

The land with the nature of which I am unacquainted I have coloured yellow, between the Derwent and the north and east boundaries of the District. West of the Derwent it was useless to do so, as there is no definite boundary on that side. The land left uncoloured (north east of Derwent) is worthless, or nearly so. The Gordon and Florentine Country is not included in the estimate.

The Florentine Valley contains a large extent of good Agricultural land, and the climate is good. The great distance from a market, the want of pasture in the vicinity on which cattle could be kept for carrying on the work of clearing, and the very great expenditure required for that work, have prevented the occupation of any land in this valley.

The Gordon Country consists of a large extent of open land covered with coarse herbage, on which it has been found impossible to pasture either sheep or cattle with profit. It is probable that grasses of good quality might be substituted for the present worthless growth; but this substitution would involve a large expenditure, and is not likely to be attempted as long as eight or ten per cent. can be obtained for capital without risk.

An estimate of the above kind is necessarily approximate only; but I have depicted each class of land, and stated the areas as accurately as the information of which I am possessed will allow.

SIR,
In forwarding to you the Chart of my District, coloured according to your instructions, it is hardly necessary for me to state that the distinguishing limits assigned to the Crown Lands are chiefly supplied from recollection, and must therefore be taken as but rough approximations. Without actual survey no close estimate can be made. Still I have supplied all the information that a tolerably extensive acquaintance with my District enables me to afford.

With regard to the land coloured red, and classed as "Agricultural," I do not mean that the whole is fit for cultivation, but simply that patches of arable ground, more or less extensive, exist in the localities indicated, and that the remaining portion is grazing land. Many small farms might be formed from these, though I cannot at present recommend the land for the purpose, owing to its remoteness from market, difficulty of access, &c.; but I have no doubt that not only the portion indicated by me, but much of that occupied as Pastoral, and unimproved save by fencing, will eventually be cultivated and applied to the purposes of the dairy or fattening stock, for which it is well adapted.

The agricultural patches on the Dee and Lake Echo are more or less densely covered with dogwood, sassafras, cutting-grass, &c., and bear a general resemblance to the more lightly scrubbed parts of the Huon District.

The remaining agricultural land partakes more of the general character of the Lake District, viz.—marshes alternating with lightly-timbered and stony hills of the trap-rock formation. Without actual survey, it is impossible to estimate the number of arable acres, as the ground is of very variable character.

Those Pastoral lands coloured burnt sienna, on the average I should say, support about one sheep to three acres during the Summer six months, say from October till April, when the flocks are withdrawn to the "home run," and but a few of the strongest wethers left up for the Winter. The value of these high-land runs is most appreciated in dry Summers,—as when everything down below is parched up these upland pastures are in their prime.

Those Pastoral lands imperfectly delineated by the yellow colour are partly unknown to me, and consist of inferior feed land. The country may be described as consisting generally of hills with low scrub of the Dwarf Gum, (intersected by numerous small creeks running through narrow and mossy marshes), with here and there open grassy glades. This portion is not habitable for sheep for more than three months in the year, owing to its great elevation, and exposure to the westerly winds with their accompanying snow-storms. Of its probable extent I have made the best estimate in my power,—derived partly from my own observation, and partly from information I have obtained at various times from others.

In the above Table I give the estimated area of each description of Crown land.

SIR, I have the honor to forward, by this day's post, Plan of my Survey District, comprising the County of Pembroke and part of the County of Glamorgan,—coloured as required by your letter of instructions of 30th April.

I have carried out those instructions with as much care and precision as my knowledge of these lands will admit, and find the above calculation to be the result, viz.—about 5342 acres Agricultural lands, 242,184 acres Grazing land, and 84,273 acres unknown, or of a very inferior quality.

It may not be out of place here to call your attention to the very limited extent of the Agricultural area in this District, and which may doubtless strike the casual observer as being greatly in disproportion to the area of Grazing lands, or those of unknown and comparatively worthless country; but to those who are in any way conversant with the general character of the District it will be thoroughly understood, as it is well known that with the exception of the parishes in the southern part of the County of Pembroke, and those lands already alienated from the Crown, it cannot be rated as an Agricultural District; indeed, it is difficult to select Agricultural sections, and seldom attempted beyond from fifteen to fifty or one hundred acres,—and those generally in isolated situations, and even then a considerable proportion of worthless land unavoidably taken in. To my knowledge there is not one tract of country worthy of being reserved as an Agricultural area, unless it be the Carlton Scrub; and from the known character of that country it is not at all probable that sectional areas could be marked off contiguously as heretofore done; nevertheless it may be quite possible small selections would be made, provided access could be secured by the formation of roads. And this naturally suggests the question, Is there sufficient land of value to justify such an outlay?

SIR,
I herewith return the Map, and in compliance with your instructions have coloured all I believe to be suitable for agriculture with pink, and those portions I believe to be suitable for pasture only with burned umber. I unfortunately had the whole coloured before I observed your instructions required pasture to be coloured with burned sienna; I hope this may not prove any inconvenience to you.

The Lots 32, 105, 105a, 108 and part of 125, Harrison lessees, are not wholly fit for agriculture, but I know that much of the land in each of these lots is quite equal to the small lots (which I take to be marked off for agriculture) in Dulverton Parish. Lot 80, White lessee, is similarly circumstanced. Lot 72, Brown lessee, and 73 and 102, Pillenger lessee, contain much that is valuable for agriculture, particularly when proximity to Oatlands is taken into account. I think two-thirds of these lots may fairly be considered fit for agriculture, Lot 147 & 73 more elevated and rocky. The land leased to J. A. Allison I am of opinion that it is a greater breadth than I have indicated by pink, but I cannot with any certainty mark the whereabouts. The four lots at the S.W. angle of the Plan I am not sufficiently acquainted with to form a decided opinion of their character, but, from what I do know, believe they are only fit for pasture. So many years have elapsed since I made any surveys in the Eastern Marsh neighbourhood that I am in a similar difficulty in reference to the lots occupied by Dickson, Jillett, and Tabart, and my old notes cannot help, as they distinguish between good and indifferent pasture only. I have been through these lots several times, and believe them fit for pasture only with strips of black bottom in some of them, which gives them nearly all the value they possess.
