## MEMO.

*Proposed New Schools, angle of Charles and Canning-streets, Launceston.*

Area of Mixed School, 70 ft. × 23 ft. = 1610 ft., accommodate.....	Children. 180
Area of Class Room 40 ft. × 20 ft. ....	80

Buildings to be of brick, on concrete and bluestone foundations, with brown stone sills and bands to windows, as shown on elevation. Roofs to be slated, inside to be open timbered to a height of about 22 feet, boarded on top of rafters and collars, and varnished. Walls boarded to a height of 4 feet 6 inches above floors, above that plastered. Ventilation by valved air trunks above boarded ceilings, communicating with dormers shown on roof, with Tobin's inlet tubes. Closets to be "Jennings' Patent Latrines" arranged expressly for Schools, the water-flushing apparatus being in a compartment under the sole control of the Master.

This plan, as regards extent of accommodation and probable cost, might be adopted for the second School in Launceston, proposed to be built on a site near the Court House, and also for the contemplated School at Battery Point, Hobart. The arrangements would probably require some modification to suit the different sites, but without increasing cost, &c.

## MEMO.

*Beaconsfield Schools and Master's Residence.*

Accommodation for 210 Children, including Infants.

Estimate of probable cost about £1650, calculating for rubble stone foundations, weather-board buildings, shingled roofs, inside linings to be plaster, but all School-rooms, &c. to be boarded to height of window sills.

Closets to be the earth system, or *shallow* cesspools, with easy access for frequently emptying.

This estimate does not include boundary or division fences, but buildings, closets, and covered sheds complete.
