PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES, SUPERANNUATION AND ALLOWANCES AMENDMENT BILL 2011

(Brought in by the Premier, the Honourable Larissa Tahireh Giddings)

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Parliamentary Salaries, Superannuation and Allowances Act 1973

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary* Salaries, Superannuation and Allowances Amendment Act 2011.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on 1 July 2011 but if it does not receive the Royal Assent by that date it is taken to have commenced on 1 July 2011.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Parliamentary Salaries*, *Superannuation and Allowances Act 1973** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4. Schedule 1 amended (Salaries payable to members)

Schedule 1 to the Principal Act is amended by inserting after clause 3E in Part I the following clause:

3EA. Notwithstanding clause 3E, the amount that the Auditor-General is to determine under clause 3E(a) and which is to have effect on and from 1 July 2011 is to be 102 per cent of the amount that was determined by the Auditor-General to have effect from 1 July 2010.

5. Repeal of Act

This Act is repealed on the ninetieth day from the day on which it commences.
