A BILL FOR

An Act to repeal the Tasmania Together Progress Board Act 2001

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Tasmania Together Progress Board Repeal Act 2012*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on a day to be proclaimed.

3. Legislation repealed

The legislation specified in Schedule 1 is repealed.

4. Legislation revoked

The legislation specified in Schedule 2 is revoked.

5. Administration of Act

Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1990* –

- (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Premier; and
- (b) the department responsible to the Premier in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Premier and Cabinet.
