## Gas (Consequential Amendments) Bill 2018

Madam Speaker, I move that the Bill now be read a second time.

This Bill is relatively straight forward in all respects. It will update a number of Acts and Regulations to ensure that they reflect the changes in references from the *Gas Act 2000* and the *Gas Pipelines Act 2000*, to the realigned Gas Industry Bill 2018 and the Gas Safety Bill 2018.

Where there are continuing requirements or obligations in a range of other legislation, these processes or responsibilities will continue unchanged.

Where a reference in the Gas Act or the Gas Pipelines Act related to safety provisions, that reference has been replaced with a reference to the Gas Safety Act 2018.

And further, where the reference in the Gas Act or the Gas Pipelines Act related to licensing, integration with land access or other non-safety regulatory matters, that reference has been replaced with a reference to the Gas Industry Act 2018.

This Bill is not seeking to revoke any of the obligations or requirements under the legislation being amended.

Madam Speaker, I commend the Bill to the House.
