- 1 COUNCIL MEETS.**— The Council met at 11.00 o'clock in the forenoon
- 2 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL PEOPLE.**— The President said: “We meet today on Tasmanian Aboriginal land. We acknowledge and pay respect to the Tasmanian Aboriginal people and elders, past, present and emerging. We recognise them as the traditional and original owners and the continuing custodians of this land.”
- 3 PRAYERS.**— The President read Prayers.
- 4 PAPERS.**— The Clerk of the Council laid upon the Table the following Papers:—
- (1) Land Acquisition Act 1993: Notice of Acquisition of land under Section 18, comprising area of land containing 149m² situate in Tasman Highway Great Eastern Drive – Access to Piermont Property Swansea, Municipal area of Glamorgan-Spring Bay.

 - (5) Land Acquisition Act 1993: Notice of Acquisition of land under Section 18, comprising area of land containing 11.8m² situate in Tasman Highway Great Eastern Drive – Entrance to East Coast Natureworld, Municipal area of Glamorgan-Spring Bay.
- 5 BILL NO. 20.** — The Biosecurity (Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Bill 2020 was read the Third time and passed.
