Inquiry into the King Island Shipping and Freight Service

Legislative Council Government Administration Committee 'A' has recently formed a Sub-Committee to inquire into the King Island Shipping and Freight Service.

The Inquiry was established to investigate:

- 1. The current shipping and freight requirements of King Island, including freight costs and other charges related to shipping to and from King Island;
- 2. The impact of high freight charges on the cost of doing business and the cost of living on King Island;
- 3. The adequacy of the current port facilities on King Island and ports in North West Tasmania that may service King Island;
- 4. The requirements to provide a sustainable service to meet current and future freight needs of King Island; and
- 5. Any other matter incidental thereto.

The Sub-Committee intends to conduct public hearings on King Island and in Hobart in August 2017.
