## PUBLIC ACCOUNTS:

SECOND REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEE.

Brought up by Mr. Treasurer, March 20, 1923, and ordered by the House of Assembly to be printed.

### REPORT.

The Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to present the following Report :—

#### EMU BAY COUNCIL APPLICATION.

Your Committee having taken into consideration an application from the Emu Bay Council for a loan of £4000 for—

- (1) Paying for Land Purchased for Erection of Building and Machine,
- (2) Paying for Purchase of Diesel Oil Engine,
- (3) Paying for Erection of Machinery, and Expenses in connection with same,
- (4) Extensions of Electric Light Service—

recommends the same to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House, with the stipulation that a Sinking Fund of 2 per cent. be provided for in the Bill to grant such Loan.

#### CLARENCE COUNCIL APPLICATION.

A further application considered by your Committee was from the Clarence Council for a Loan of £600 for the purchase of about three acres of land, known as "The Quarry Block," situated at Bellerive. The application is recommended for approval with a Sinking Fund of 2 per cent.
