# REPORT.

The Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to present the following Report:--

## EMU BAY COUNCIL APPLICATION.

Your Committee having taken into consideration an application from the Emu Bay Council for a loan of £4000 for-

- (1) Paying for Land Purchased for Erection of Building and Machine,
- (2) Paying for Purchase of Diesel Oil Engine,
- (3) Paying for Erection of Machinery, and Expenses in connection with same,
  (4) Extensions of Electric Light Service—

recommends the same to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House, with the stipulation that a Sinking Fund of 2 per cent. be provided for in the Bill to grant such Loan.

### CLARENCE COUNCIL APPLICATION.

A further application considered by your Committee was from the Clarence Council for a Loan of £600 for the purchase of about three acres of land, known as "The Quarry Block," situated at Bellerive. The application is recommended for approval with a Sinking Fund of 2 per cent.
