- 1 **COUNCIL MEETS.** The Council met at 11.00 o'clock a.m.
- **2 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL PEOPLE.** The President said: "We meet today on Tasmanian Aboriginal land. We acknowledge and pay respect to the Tasmanian Aboriginal people and elders, past and present. We recognise them as the traditional and original owners and the continuing custodians of this land."
- **PRAYERS.** The President read Prayers.
- **4 PAPER.** The Clerk of the Council laid upon the Table the Tasmanian Planning Commission: State of the Environment Report 2024 Volume 1: Summary report and Volume 2: Technical reports.
- **5 MOTION WITHOUT NOTICE.** *Ordered*, That Mrs *Hiscutt* have leave to move a Motion without Notice.
- **6 LEAVE OF ABSENCE.** *Ordered,* That the Honourable Member for Mersey, (Mr *Gaffney*) be granted leave of absence from the service of the Council for this week's sittings. (Mrs *Hiscutt*)
- **7 SPECIAL INTEREST MATTERS.** The President advised the Chamber of two Members who had indicated their desire to speak:—
 - (1) Ms Thomas Spontaneous Coronary Artery Dissection (SCAD); and
 - (2) Ms *Palmer* Tresca Neighbourhood House.

At the conclusion of Special Interest Matters the Council proceeded to Orders of the Day.

- **8 BILL NO. 20.** The Forestry (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2024 was read the Third time and passed.
