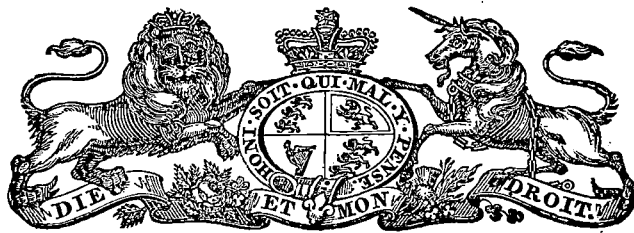

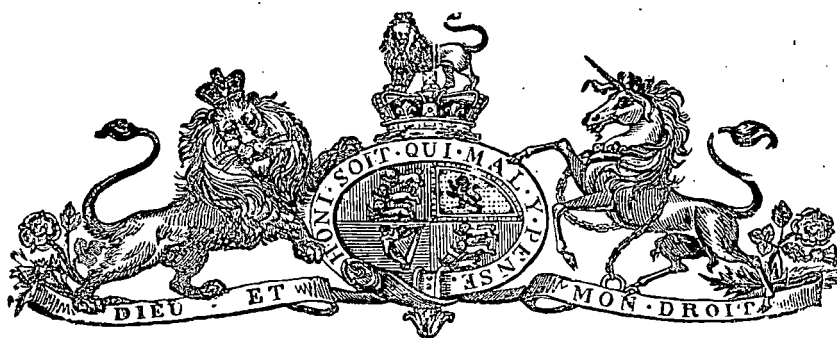

HOBART PUBLIC CEMETERY.

Hobart, 11th May, 1881.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to forward the usual Returns connected with the Hobart Public Cemetery for the year ended 31st December, 1880.

The number of deaths in the Hobart District during 1880 was 648, being 6 more than in 1879.

The receipts from interments £590 14s., a slight increase upon the previous year.

The Trustees beg to draw your especial attention to the fact of the Cemetery Debentures falling due in August and October next. In doing so they desire, most strongly, to urge upon the Government the absolute necessity for at once considering the scheme for the financial adjustment of the Cemetery Fund, which was submitted in the Report for 1878. Reference to the above has been made annually in the Reports of the Institution; and until the scheme is carried into effect, or some other measure of relief substituted therefor, it is utterly impossible to effect improvements in the Cemetery.
