



## ANDREW MARVEL'S CASE:

REPORT OF SELECT COMMITTEE.

Brought up by Mr. Dumaresq, and ordered by the House of Assembly to be printed, October 29, 1891.



REPORT of the Select Committee appointed to inquire into and report upon the Claim of E. Marvel.

Your Committee have the honor to report to your Honorable House that they have taken evidence re Marvel's Case, and that from oral and documentary evidence taken and duly considered, they are of opinion that it has been conclusively proved that E. Marvel sustained serious and permanent injury in the execution of his duty on the 12th day of September, 1884, the said injuries incapacitating him from further employment in the Railway Department; and that such injuries were caused while Marvel was returning home on a trolly, through the negligence of a ganger in charge of a trolly following.

Your Committee having carefully considered the circumstances of the case, have the honor to recommend to your Honorable House that one year's pay be granted to the Petitioner as compensation in full for the injury sustained.
