



PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

QUARANTINE (CATTLE) REGULATIONS:

PETITION.

Presented by Mr. Dodery, October 10; and ordered by the Legislative Council to be printed, October 16, 1884.



To the Honorable the President and Members of the Legislative Council of Tasmania, in Parliament assembled.

WE, the undersigned Stock-owners, respectfully pray your Honorable House to take into consideration, with a view to amending, the Clause in the Quarantine Regulations enforcing "six months" detention, and that you will be pleased to relax this Regulation to the extent of allowing cattle to pass at the expiration of "three months," if certified to by the Government Inspector.
