

# BOARD OF IMMIGRATION:

## REPORT FOR 1877.

Laid upon the Table by Mr. Moore, and ordered by the Council to be printed, July 16, 1878.

(No. 20.)



#### Immigration Office, 18th March, 1878.

SIR, THE Board of Immigration have the honor to forward their Annual Report for the year ended 31st December, 1877.

The number of Immigrants who came out under the Bounty System was smaller than for some years past, while the number of tickets issued was larger.

The Immigrants introduced consisted of one married couple, three single males, and two single females,—in all seven souls; and the cost to the Board was fifty-seven pounds.

Land Certificates were granted to thirty-four individuals under the 7th Section of the Act 31 Vict. No. 26, entitling them to select seventeen hundred and sixty acres of the waste lands of the Crown. These Certificates represent twenty-seven male and twenty-three female adults, and fortytwo children,—in all ninety-two souls.

Five Land Orders were issued under the 5th Section of the same Act, entitling the holders to select five hundred and ninety-four acres of land, and representing twelve male and eight female adults and twenty children,—in all forty souls.

During the year the Board issued nine family, six male, and fourteen female Bounty Tickets, receiving the sum of two hundred and sixty-five pounds in payment.

In August last the Board issued instructions for the printing in London of a revised edition of the Paper entitled "Information for intending Emigrants," to the number of 10,000. Of these 1000 will be sent to the Colony, 7000 are to be handed to the Agents of the Board in London for distribution by their local Agents in different parts of the United Kingdom, and 2000 they have decided to place at the disposal of Mr. Richall Richardson, a gentleman who proposes to travel through England with an Exhibition of Tasmanian products, and to deliver lectures on the Colony.

The balance at the disposal of the Board on the 31st December amounted to £5780 19s. 7d.

Appended are the usual Returns prepared by the Immigration Agent,—five relating to the operations of the Board under the Bounty System, and two to transactions under the Acts of Parliament 31 Vict. No. 26, and 38 Vict. No. 16.

A statement is also appended showing the acreage taken up by the holders of Land Certificates and Land Orders since the date of the last Report.
