# **MENTAL HEALTH AMENDMENT BILL 2011**

## **A BILL FOR**

### **An Act to amend the *Mental Health Amendment Act 2005***

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

#### **1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Mental Health Amendment Act 2011*.

#### **2. Commencement**

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

#### **3. Principal Act**

In this Act, the *Mental Health Amendment Act 2005*\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

**4. Section 19 amended (Expiry)**

Section 19(1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting “6 years and 6 months” and substituting “8 years and 6 months”.

**5. Repeal of Act**

This Act is repealed on the ninetieth day from the day on which it commences.
