# **FORESTRY AMENDMENT BILL 2002**

(Brought in by the Minister for Economic Development, Energy and Resources, the Honourable Paul Anthony Lennon)

#### **A BILL FOR**

#### An Act to amend the *Forestry Act 1920*

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

#### Short title

**1.** This Act may be cited as the *Forestry Amendment Act 2002*.

## Commencement

**2.** This Act commences on the day on which the *Government Business Enterprises Amendment Act 2002* commences.

## **Principal Act**

**3.** In this Act, the *Forestry Act 1920*<sup>\*</sup> is referred to as the Principal Act.

#### Section 12M amended (Chief executive officer)

**4.** Section 12M of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsections (2) and (3) and substituting the following subsection:

(2) The Board must not appoint the chairperson as chief executive officer.

#### **Schedule 2 amended (Directors)**

**5.** Schedule 2 to the Principal Act is amended as follows:

- (a) by omitting from clause 1(1) "5 years" and substituting "3 years";
- (b) by omitting subclauses (2) and (3) from clause 1 and substituting the following subclauses:

(2) A director who is also the chief executive officer holds the office of director while he or she is the chief executive officer.

(3) A person is not eligible to be appointed as a director if the person has attained the age of 72 years.

(4) If a director held office as director immediately before the commencement of the *Forestry Amendment Act 2002* and his or her instrument of appointment provided for a term of office exceeding 3 years –

- (a) subclause (1) does not apply in respect of that term of office; and
- (b) the director is entitled to complete that term of office as if that subclause had not been amended by that Act.
