

PROTEST

BY THREE MEMBERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SPRING BAY AGAINST CERTAIN PAYMENTS OF MONEY.

Laid upon the Table by Mr. Attorney-General, and ordered by the House to be printed, 7 July, 1863.



Spring Bay, 24th June, 1863.

We, the undersigned Councillors of the Municipality of Spring Bay, publicly protest against the payment to John Felmingham of the sum of Three hundred Pounds in three Bills of One hundred Pounds each, the same having been given to him without our sanction or approval, as payment of the Balance due to him for the erection of the new Council Chamber and Police Office at Spring Bay; the work not being completed according to Contract, and the Inspector of Police having refused to pass the Buildings as efficient until such Contract shall be completed.
