## **1 COUNCIL MEETS.**— The Council met at 11.00 o'clock in the forenoon.

**2 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL PEOPLE.**— The President said: "We meet today on Tasmanian Aboriginal land. We acknowledge and pay respect to the Tasmanian Aboriginal people and elders, past, present and emerging. We recognise them as the traditional and original owners and the continuing custodians of this land."

**3 PRAYERS.**— The President read Prayers.

- 4 **PAPERS.** The Clerk of the Council laid upon the Table the following Papers:—
  - (1) Guidelines for Notifying 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV). Containing legal requirements for laboratories and medical practitioners. Effective 6 February 2020.
  - (2) Guidelines for Notifying Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Containing legal requirements for laboratories and medical practitioners. Effective 5 March 2020.

**5 BILL NO. 56 OF 2019.**— The Order of the Day was read for the consideration of the Duties Amendment Bill 2019 as amended in Committee of the Whole Council.
