**4 LEAVE OF ABSENCE.**— *Ordered*, That the Honourable Member for Hobart, (Mr *Valentine*) be granted leave of absence from the service of the Council for this day's sitting. (Mrs *Hiscutt*)

**5 BILL NO. 51.** — The Gaming Control Amendment (Wagering) Bill 2019 was read the Third time and passed.

It was resolved in the Affirmative.

And the Bill was, accordingly, read the Second time and committed to a Committee of the Whole Council.

And the President having left the Chair, the Council resolved itself into the said Committee.

Clauses 1 to 31 agreed to.

Clause 32 postponed.

Clauses 33 to 98 agreed to.

Postponed Clause 32 as read, further considered.

To report progress and seek leave to sit again.

The Council being resumed Ms *Rattray* reported that the Committee had made progress in the Bill, and that she was directed to move that the Committee may have leave to sit again.

Resolved, That the Council will, at a later hour, again resolve itself into the said Committee.

Clause 32 Amendment proposed (Ms Forrest)

Page 48, subsection (4), paragraph (c), subparagraph (ii).

Leave out "from the State, or a council,".

The proposed Amendment was, by leave, withdrawn.

To report progress and seek leave to sit again.

The Council being resumed, Ms *Rattray* reported that the Committee had made progress in the Bill, and that she was directed to move that the Committee may have leave to sit again.

Resolved, That the Council will, tomorrow, again resolve itself into the said Committee.
