- 1 COUNCIL MEETS.— The Council met at 11.00 o'clock in the forenoon and the President read Prayers.
- **2 BILL NO. 61 OF 2018.** The Forest Practices Amendment Bill 2018 was read the Third time and passed.
- **3 BILL NO. 61 OF 2018.** A Message to the House of Assembly:—
