Sentencing Amendment (Drug Treatment Orders) Bill 2016

The Sentencing Amendment (Drug Treatment Orders) Bill 2016 provides for amendments to the Sentencing Act 1997 to clarify the operation of the Court Mandated Drug Diversion program and validate drug treatment orders made under Part 3A of the Act after 30 June 2014.

The Bill amends the Sentencing Act 1997 by:

- inserting a definition of "drug treatment order";
- repealing section 27Y so that the operation of Part 3A no longer has an expiration date or is time limited; and
- providing that any action, decision, direction, requirement, order, warrant, sentence made under Part 3A of the Sentencing Act 1997 made after 30 June 2014 is not invalid.
