I am writing to provide TTF's submission to the Legislative Council Committee Inquiry on Integrated Transport Options. TTF would like the inquiry to consider the enclosed major research report which examines the role of the private sector in delivering public transport services.

Public Transport, Private Operators; Delivering Better Public Transport through Franchising was prepared by TTF in partnership with L.E.K. Consulting and draws on extensive domestic and global experience in public transport. It also includes the outcomes of focus group research conducted by GA Research on TTF's behalf.

In summary, the report finds that franchising has the potential to deliver better customer service and innovation, more efficient management of public transport services and reduces government subsidies.

The report has a significant focus on how franchising can best be managed for bus operations, which remains particularly relevant to Tasmania.
