To the Committee

As a long term permanent resident at 20 Hambledon Avenue Park Grove I oppose the proposed relocation of the Burnie Courts to the vacant university complex in Mooreville Road.

This area has been developed as an Educational, Residential and Retirement home area. There is currently a large primary school, a Day care centre, Secondary College and Tafe College and Umina Park home for the elderly adjacent to the proposed site. Students and residents do not need to be exposed to the incidents which currently occur outside the courts.

There is considerable traffic congestion at peak times and relocation of the Burnie Courts will only exacerbate this.

There are two pedestrian crossings with crossing guards catering for students walking to and from school.

There is no co-located shop or Cafe to cater for users of the proposed Court.

Access to legal and other support services will no longer be available in the immediate vicinity and will require a several kilometre journey on public transport for some which currently is insufficient.

I request that consideration be given to retaining the Court Complex within the CBD where it can best serve the clients, legal fraternity, support services and the community.
