**MEMORANDUM FOR :**

I write to advise that the Legislative Council today resolved —

- (1) That a Select Committee be appointed, with power to send for persons and papers, with leave to sit during any adjournment of the Council, to inquire into and report upon matters related to the Recommendations made in the Final Report of the Commission of Inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's Response to Child Sexual Abuse in Institutional Settings (the Recommendations), including:
  - (a) the Tasmanian Government's response and plan to implement the Recommendations;
  - (b) the Tasmanian Government's progress of the implementation of the Recommendations;
  - (c) the outcomes related to the Recommendations for both partially and fully implemented recommendations;
- (2) And, that the initial schedule of hearings as set out below be adopted as the Committee's timetable for initial hearings:

Tuesday 26 March 2024: 9:00am – 11:00am Premier

Tuesday 26 March 2024: 11:30am – 6:30pm Minister for Health

Wednesday 27 March 2024: 9:00am – 4:00pm Minister for Education, Children and Young People

Thursday 28 March 2024: 9:00am – 1:00pm Attorney General and Minister for Justice

Thursday 28 March 2024: 2:00pm – 6:00pm Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Management
- (3) And, that the Committee present an Interim Report on this inquiry by no later than Tuesday 9 April 2024;
- (4) And, That the Members of the Committee be:

- (5) And, That a Message be transmitted to the House of Assembly requesting that the House of Assembly give leave to the Ministers named in paragraph (2) to appear before and give evidence to the Committee at the aforementioned times.
