### REPORT.

The Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to present the following report on the Glenorchy Water Bill, No. 66, and the application from the Municipality of St. Leonards for a loan of £1000 :—

#### GLENORCHY WATER BILL.

In respect to this Bill, which seeks power to borrow the sum of £1000 for water-supply improvements, your Committee, having examined the Bill, recommends the same to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House, provided that it is framed on the general principles laid down in "The Local Bodies' Loans Act."

#### ST. LEONARDS MUNICIPALITY APPLICATION.

This was an application for a loan of £1000 for sewerage purposes at Invermay and Mowbray. It is recommended for approval.
