Hello, my name is Missy, I'm 20 years old, and I currently live in Melbourne. My older sister, who is 32 and lives in Hobart, recently welcomed my beautiful niece, nicknamed [REDACTED], in [REDACTED] after years of heartache and struggle.

My sister faced numerous challenges with her pregnancies due to unexplained miscarriages, which led her into a deep depression. The emotional pain and grief from losing her babies were devastating. During her pregnancy with [REDACTED], she remained anxious and had frequent checkups to ensure everything was okay. About a month before her due date, concerns about her baby's size added to the family's worries.

The labour itself was incredibly difficult for her, lasting 36 hours, and the pain was so intense that she still finds it hard to discuss her birthing experience even 10 months later.

My sister also had to say goodbye to three other babies who didn't make it: [REDACTED] due [REDACTED]; [REDACTED] due [REDACTED]; and [REDACTED] due [REDACTED].

I urge you to consider the needs of all pregnant individuals in Tasmania and ensure they receive the support and care they deserve.
