Pursuant to section 24(1)(e) of the Integrity Commission Act 2009, the Joint Standing Committee on Integrity is required to review “the functions, powers and operations of the Integrity Commission” after three years of the commencement of its operation.

The Committee accordingly invites interested persons or organisations to make written submissions to the Committee, the closing date for which is **Friday, 22 August 2014**. Submissions must address the abovementioned terms of review.

This is a further call for submissions – submissions already provided to the Committee in response to the previous advertisement need not be resubmitted.
