

#### REPORT for 1888.

Hobart, 22nd January, 1889.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to hand you the following Report of the Ladies' Committee of Girls' Training School Reformatory for the past twelve months.

The work of the Institution has gone on quietly and steadily, and continues to be self-supporting, and has now a sum of £353 10s. 11d. towards a building or reserve fund.

The average number of inmates for the year has been ten, and their behaviour on the whole good. Five girls were admitted during the year, two coming in voluntarily. No girls left this year.

The girls are employed in washing, housework, cooking, and needlework; and receive Bible lessons, and instruction in reading, writing, and arithmetic.

The amount earned during the year by washing is £282 7s. 7d.

Again the Committee desire to record their appreciation of the untiring energy of the Matron, which so materially helps towards the success of the Institution.

There has been a new verandah built from the ironing-room to the wash-house, and the Matron's rooms papered and painted, at a cost of £14 18s. 6d.
