



SIR,

I HAVE the honor to submit the Annual Report of this Institution for the year 1891.

The number of admissions for the whole period was 18. This was the same number as for the year 1890.

Birth-places of Inmates.

16 of the patients were natives of the Colony, 1 was born in England, 1 in Scotland. 14 were Protestants and 4 were Roman Catholics. This was also the same for the year 1890.
