



## LAUNCESTON GAS COMPANY.

REPORT OF THE SELECT COMMITTEE.

Brought up by Mr. Chapman, and ordered by the House to be printed, 22 October, 1858.



THE Select Committee to whom the Bill, entitled "A Bill to simplify Proceedings at Law and in Equity by or against the Launceston Gas Company, to restrict within certain Limits the Responsibility of the Shareholders, and for other Purposes," was referred on the 20th instant have agreed to the following

## REPORT.

YOUR Committee, having been attended by the Solicitor for the promoters of the Bill, and having taken evidence in support of the allegations contained in the Preamble, have the honor to report that the Preamble of the Bill has been proved to the satisfaction of your Committee.

Your Committee, having agreed that the Preamble should stand part of the Bill, then entered upon the consideration of its several Clauses and Schedules, and agreed upon the several Amendments thereto which are shown in ink on the printed copy of the Bill signed by the Chairman of your Committee, and hereto annexed.

Your Committee, therefore, would recommend the Bill, as so amended, to the favourable consideration of your Honorable House.
