

PETITION FROM WESTWOOD ROAD TRUST AGAINST DIVERSION OF GRANT.

Presented by Mr. Douglas, and ordered by the House to be printed, 23 August, 1865.

To the Honorable Members of the House of Assembly of Tasmania, in Parliament assembled.

The humble Petition of the Road Trustees and Ratepayers of the Road District of Westwood, in the Municipality of Westbury, praying that the Money now granted to the Road Trusts from the Land Fund may not be diverted to other purposes.

THAT, if the intended proposition of the Honorable the Colonial Treasurer be carried into effect, it will be highly detrimental to the interests of Ratepayers in this District, and embarrass the Road Trustees in their arrangements for the repairs and maintenance of Roads and Bridges throughout this District.
