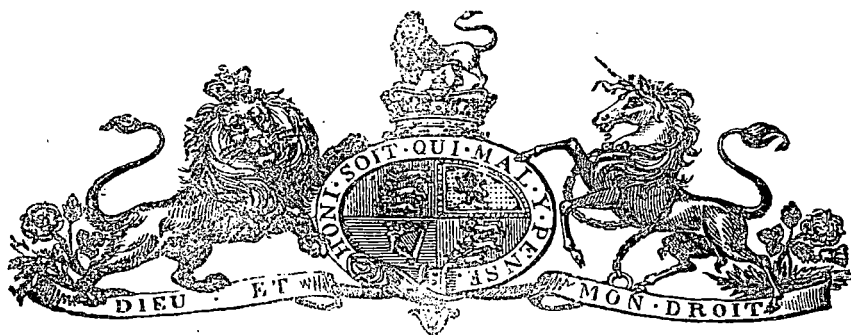

PARLIAMENT OF TASMANIA.

CHIEF INSPECTOR OF SHEEP:

REPORT FOR 1883.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by His Excellency's Command.



REPORT OF INSPECTOR OF SHEEP.

Office of Inspector of Sheep, Hobart, 30th June, 1884.

SIR,

I HAVE the honor to submit for the information of the Government the following Report of the working of the Scab Act for the last 12 months.

It affords me great satisfaction to be able to report that the flocks of the Colony continue entirely free from Scab disease; nevertheless Inspectors keep a vigilant watch over all sheep, especially those exposed for public sale, and also avail themselves of the opportunity afforded of examining the flocks when visiting properties for the more immediate purposes of the Rabbit Destruction Act and the Californian Thistle Act.

In the month of February last an extraordinary outbreak of Scab occurred at Lomax's, Erran-ang Station, Carcoar, New South Wales. The sheep referred to were said to have been exported from Tasmania. Immediately I became aware of this report I brought the circumstance under the notice of the Government, and lost no time in forwarding a cable message to the Chief Inspector of Stock, New South Wales, asking for full particulars, and requesting him to take every means in his power to contradict this damaging statement. In the course of the same day I received a reply from the Chief Inspector that the statement had been publicly refuted, that the diseased sheep had been destroyed, and every precaution taken to prevent the spread of infection.

A Commission has been appointed to thoroughly investigate the circumstances, but up to the present time, I am given to understand, no Report has been made.

The diseased sheep, it appears, were imported from America in the month of August, 1883, and the "outbreak" was not discovered until the following February. How these animals could have remained all this period in quarantine and have also undergone the dipping required by the New South Wales Quarantine Regulations without the infection (if present) being discovered, I am at a loss to know. I trust the Report of the Commissioners will show clearly what time elapsed after the sheep left the Quarantine Ground before the disease broke out.

The number of sheep accounted for up to date is about 35,000 less than shown by last year's returns, but, as usual, many shepholders have again omitted to furnish the necessary information, thus there must be some 30,000 as to which I have as yet no return. For instance, during the last six months of 1883 penalties were paid on over 20,000 for this omission.

The Quarantine Station which has been established at Middle Island, River Tamar, is now open for the reception of imported animals, and under the charge of Mr. C. G. Wood.

In the month of February last this Department suffered a loss by the death of the late Mr. J. A. Gunn, the Inspector of the South-Western Sheep District; and I desire to place on record my appreciation of his services there, having always found Mr. Gunn a diligent and painstaking officer.

This vacancy has been temporarily filled by the appointment of Mr. Francis Allison, who was formerly in the service. Mr. Allison has charge of the South-Western Sheep District.

The maintenance of the present staff, which it would be impossible to reduce without imperilling the attainment of the objects contemplated by the Acts of Parliament relating to Sheep, Cattle, Rabbits, and Thistles, will involve an excess of expenditure beyond the funds derivable from the

contribution to the Scab Act Fund for the current year to the extent of nearly £600, and it is therefore imperatively necessary that the contribution for the year 1885 should, as set forth in the Estimate I have had the honor of submitting, be fixed at not less than one halfpenny per head.

The Inspecting Staff under my control have continued to perform their duties to my entire satisfaction.

Appended will be found Returns of Sheep throughout the Island and the other usual Returns relating to Sheep, Wool, and Live Stock.
